Here is a fun, interactive lesson to teach children about coin values. First, discuss the individual value of each coin. Then, on the next pages, begin adding the coins together to find out the total value.

The Coin Values



This is a PENNY.
A penny is worth 1 cent.

1 penny = \$ 0.01
2 pennies = \$ 0.02



This is a NICKEL.
A nickel is worth 5 cents.

1 nickel = \$ 0.05
2 nickels = \$ 0.10



This is a DIME.
A dime is worth 10 cents.

1 dime = \$ 0.10
2 dimes = \$ 0.20



This is a QUARTER.
A quarter is worth 25 cents.

1 quarter = \$ 0.25
2 quarters = \$ 0.50

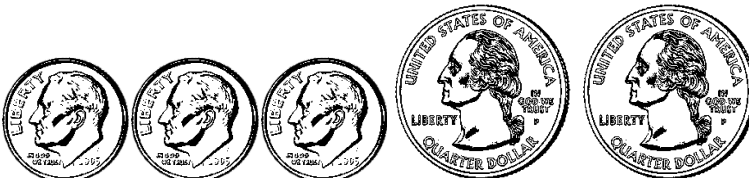
