## MOVIETIME!

Since you can't go to the movie theatre right now, why not bring the movie theatre experience to your own living room? Follow these simple steps to bring this fun activity to your family.


## Step 1

Print the attached play money provided by Cedar Point Federal Credit Union and cut the bills out. Print as much as you need for this activity. Kids will have to earn this money through chores. Then, they can "buy" movie tickets and snacks. Save this play money for other future activities. If you don't have access to a printer, have kids create their own money or use money from a board game.

## Step 2

Assign chores to your kids, and pay them in play money when the chores are completed. You decide what chores need to be done and how much they earn for completing each chore. For example, emptying the dishwasher could earn $\$ 1$, while cleaning the bathroom could earn $\$ 3$. Customize the chores and prices for your own kids. Kids do these chores during the day to earn "money" to pay for movie night.

## Step 3

Choose your movie and snacks. Decide on prices and charge your kids for tickets and snacks. If you're feeling creative, make a sign to display your prices. The kids need to count out their own money. Perhaps a ticket costs $\$ 5$, popcorn costs $\$ 3$, and a soda costs $\$ 2$. They can only purchase what they can afford.

Enjoy movie time with your family, while knowing they've learned a valuable, yet fun lesson about earning and spending money!
