

WHAT IS CARDCONTROL



CardControl allows you to set and receive alerts, control when and how your credit and debit cards are used, and monitor transactions - all from your mobile device. Get on-the-go debit/credit card alerts so you can travel with peace of mind no matter

where you go. These Instant alerts let you know the moment your card is used and can help protect against fraud, track your spending, and can be customized to alert you of specific transactions.

Please note that CardControl must be accessed through the Cedar Point digital banking app. By selecting "Cards" from the main screen. the app will prompt you to download the CardControl app. Once downloaded, the app will open alongside the Cedar Point app.
